PROJECT HISTORY / BACKGROUND

Project Goal

Manage 1.5-inches of runoff from 1.86 acres of impervious surface

Preliminary Design

- Contract awarded to ethos collaborative in 2018
- 60% design completed in December 2018
- 90% design completed in February 2019
- Estimated construction cost \$704k
- Project site identified as "suitable for divestment" by City in Open Space Plan



INTERNAL PROJECT REVIEW

Internal Review

- Completed June 2019
- Reduced scope
- Revised construction estimate \$460k

Adjusted Project Features

- Steel railing / iron fence
- Asphalt-surface path
- Ophelia Street bumpout
- Forbes Ave rain garden (small feature)



CURRENT STATUS / PROJECT SCOPE

Design Funds Approved for 2020

Project Features

- Drainage improvements
- Rain garden (at existing playground)
- Subsurface stormwater detention
- Alternate surface path
- Landscaping

Inclusion of future amenities requires funding partners
