


Scope of Work

Install pole-mounted banners on (8) lamp posts located along Main Branch's sidewalks. Based on the City's GIS maps, (5) lamp posts in proximity to Schenley Drive Extension are within the property lines of the subject parcel and the remaining (3) lamp posts at Schenley Drive are in the public right-of-way. The request is for a permanent installation of bracket and outrigger hardware onto the existing (8) lamp posts. Vinyl fabric banners designed for wind loading are be hung from the hardware, and are proposed to be periodically changed to coincide with Library Events. The Carnegie Library employs a full-time staff of graphic artists who design materials such as these banners, and all such materials are always composed to reflect and engage the City's diverse citizenry.





Lamp Post Locations






<u>Schenley Drive Extension Sidewalk – Rendering looking towards Forbes Avenue</u>






<u>Schenley Drive Sidewalk – Rendering looking towards Schenley Plaza</u>
