

# Voting updates

This year's election will look different from years past. Things to know:

- Allegheny County is using a new voting machine this year, which produces a real-time paper receipt that each voter will be able to verify.
- Don't want to vote in person? Mailin ballots allow you to vote from the safety of your home. Request a mail-in ballot via votespa.com until October 27.
- Allegheny County has arranged for eight satellite locations to provide in-person absentee voting for the weekends before election day. Voters can request, fill out, and submit a mailin ballot all in the same visit. Oakland's nearest locations are the Hill District's former Shop 'N Save, (October 17, 9am - 5pm, and October 18, 11am -7pm) and the County Office Building (October 10, 17, 24, 9am - 5pm, and October 11, 18, 25, 11am - 7pm).
