## **DLC Construction Update**

Duquesne Light is constructing a substation in Panther Hollow, and recently their work has not only affected traffic on Boundary Street but on the Schenley Bridge as well. The project is expected to be completed by the end of June 2021. Traffic on the Schenley Bridge is estimated to return to normal by the week of March 22.



## **COVID-19 Vaccine Updates**

The COVID vaccine situation is changing daily. Here is what we know as of March 7, 2021.

### Who can get a vaccine right now?

Allegheny County's vaccine distribution plan is currently in Phase 1A. Everyone age 65 and over is part of this phase.

#### Where can I get a vaccine?

Vaccines are in high demand and short supply.

- 1. If you have a primary care physician, call them first!
- UPMC is committed to delivering COVID-19 vaccines as quickly as possible. Visit https://vaccine.upmc.com and fill out a form OR call 844-876-2822 between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm any day of the week. You will be contacted as soon as a vaccine slot becomes available.
- 3. Call 2-1-1 for help scheduling a COVID vaccine or to have your vaccine questions answered.
